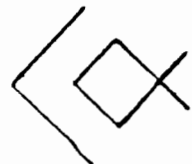

COX REUNION PRESIDENT GETS PhD

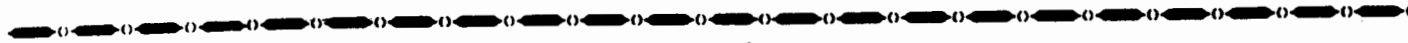

BED & BREAKFAST INN

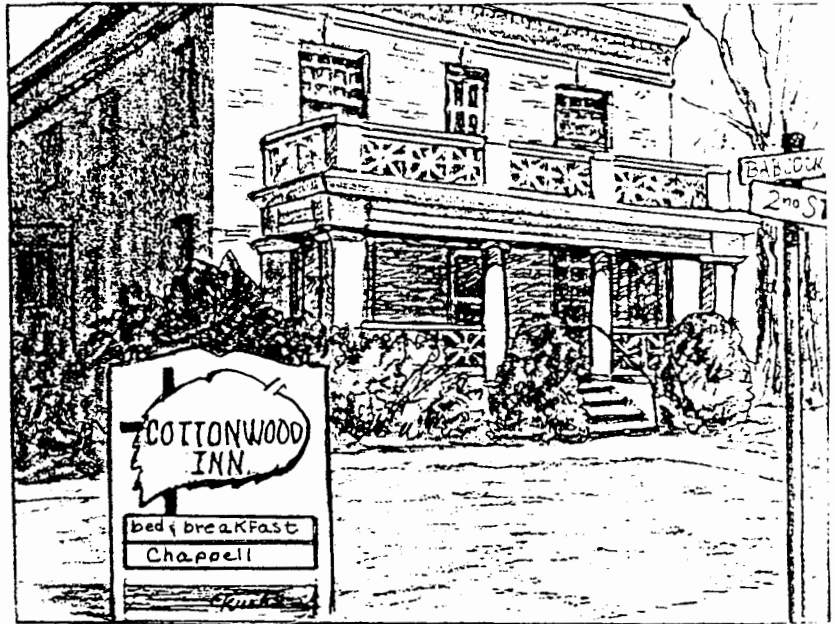
A Cox descendant, Bruce Freeman and his family have a bed and breakfast place in Chappell, NE.

Bruce and his wife, Barb will be glad to tell you of the history and of things to do in and around Chappell.



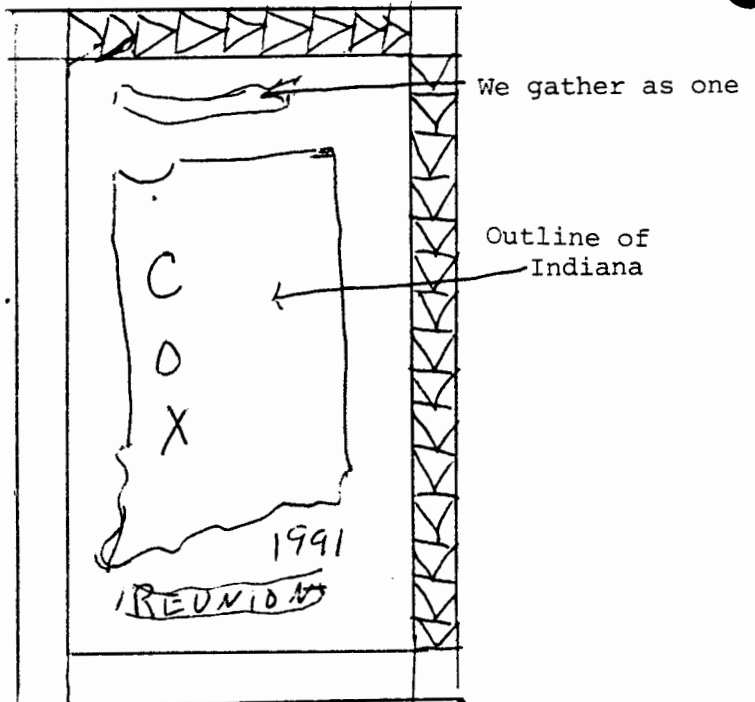
REUNION WALLHANGING
